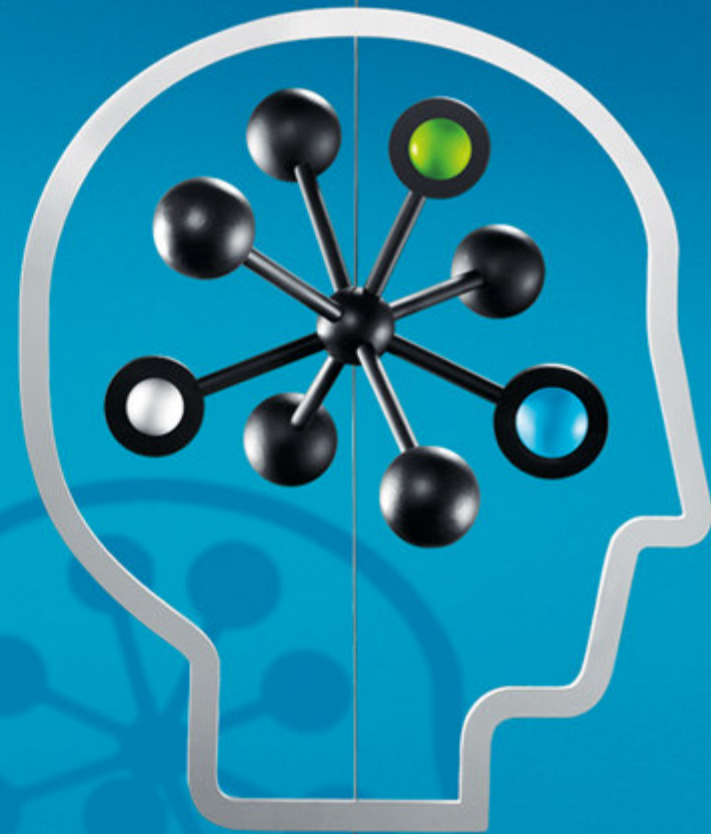

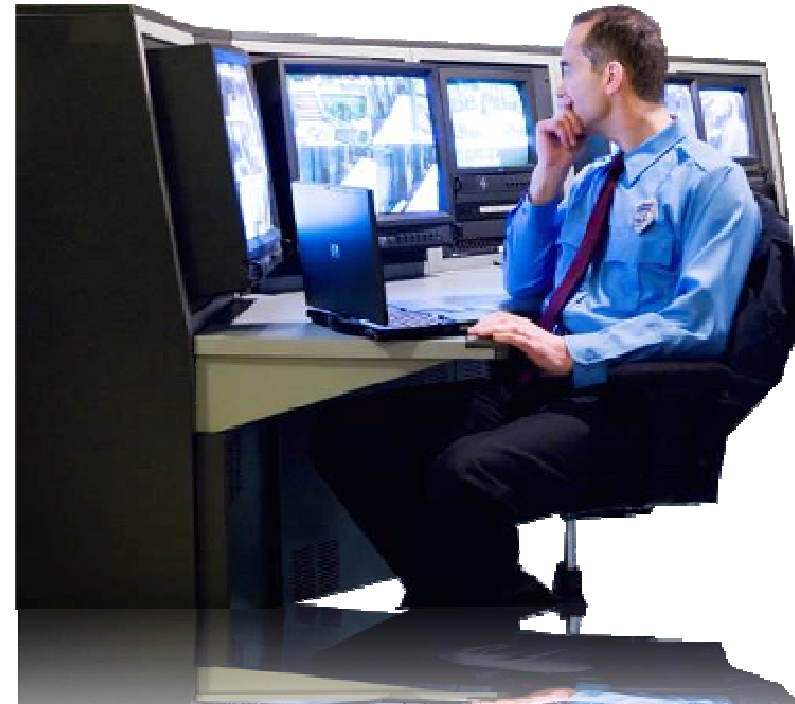

- Security need not have tradeoffs

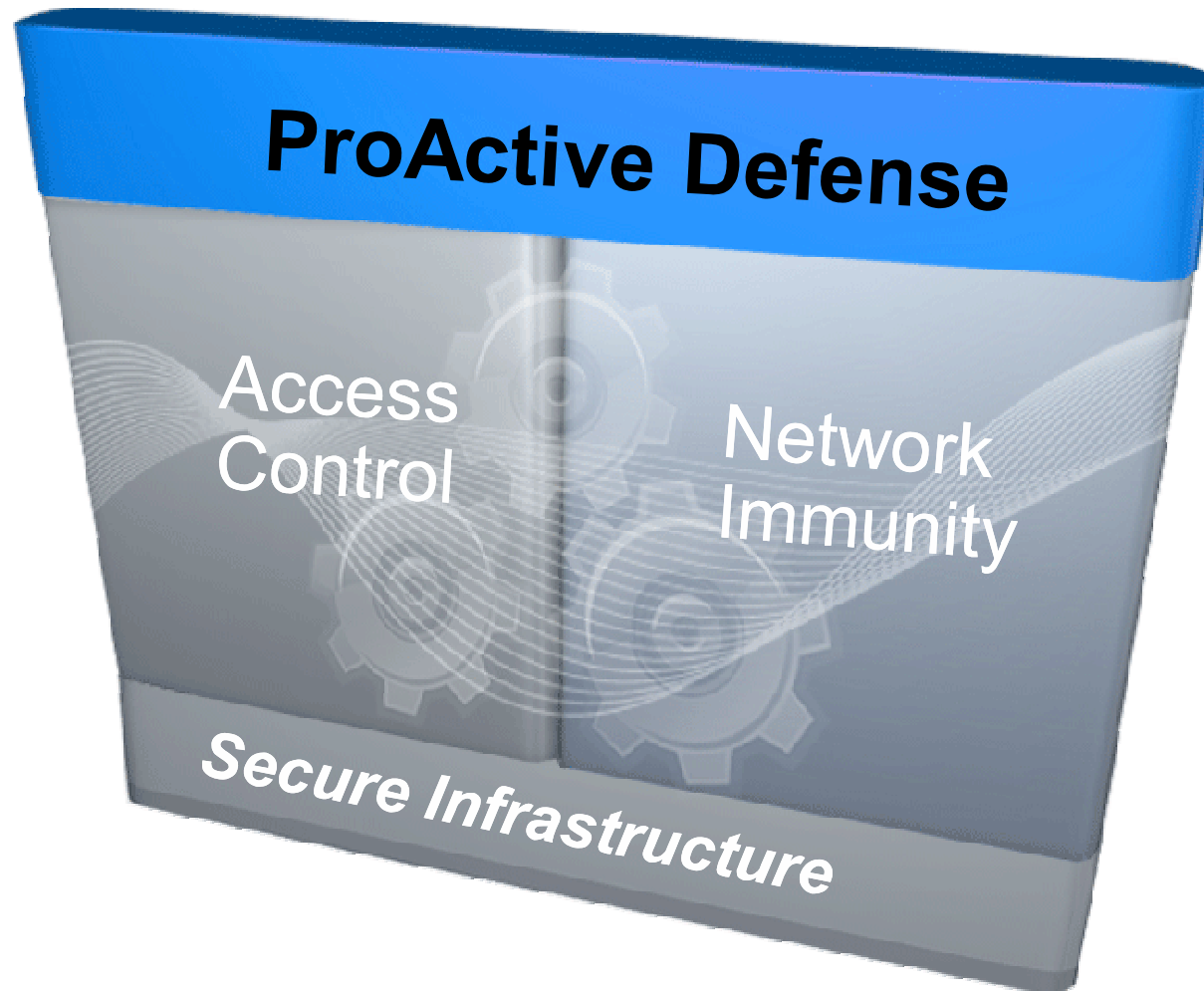
